

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-06

A RESOLUTION TO ALLOCATE \$300,000.00 TO THE HISTORIC STRUCTURE STABILIZATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Hamilton County Land Reutilization Corporation ("HCLRC") is uniquely situated to facilitate historic preservation within Hamilton County; and

WHEREAS, through the Historic Structure Stabilization Program the HCLRC can assist in stabilizing important, vacant historic buildings in order to preserve these structures for future re-use and redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, the HCLRC has formed an advisory group made up of local preservationists to assist in prioritizing the use of funds; and

WHEREAS, the funds allocated to the Historic Structure Stabilization Program in calendar years 2013 and 2014 provided for stabilization work on 6 vacant, historic structures in furtherance of the mission of the HCLRC;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the Hamilton County Land Reutilization Corporation:

Section 1. This Board hereby allocates \$300,000.00 for the Historic Structure Stabilization Program in order to ensure the preservation of historic structures for future re-use and redevelopment.

Section 2. This Board hereby finds and determines that such historic stabilization furthers the mission of the HCLRC, to remove obstacles to redevelopment and return nonproductive structures to productive use.

Section 3. This Board hereby authorizes the management company to expend all such allocated funds necessary to administer the Historic Structure Stabilization Program and to perform qualified stabilization and rehabilitation, environmental assessments, environmental remediation, contract and program compliance reviews, and all other related expenses. Notwithstanding the requirements of Code of Regulations Sections 9.4 and 9.6, this includes entering into contracts in excess of \$100,000.00 and issuing payments in excess of \$50,000.00 without requiring two authorized signatures.



Section 5. This resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.


